A growth culture is vital to keeping teachers engaged and positive while creating a thriving environment for children. This workshop outlines the key strategies early childhood education leaders require to create a culture that prioritizes continuous growth and development for teachers.

Here, we focus on answering fundamental questions today's leaders face, including:

- How do I motivate and inspire teachers to grow and develop?
- How can I develop a leadership style that encourages educators to remain current regarding knowledge and best practices?
- How can I infuse positive energy into my professional development work?
- What tools and strategies can I use to help develop the capabilities of early childhood educators within my organization?

To answer these and other questions, we will take a deep dive into how a Deliberately Developmental Organization (DDO) supports each individual's unique desire to reach their full potential. Susan will also help you develop the skills and master the tools and strategies required to support teachers as they focus on professional accountability and positivity in their work with children.

Bridges Out of Poverty – 4 part series (full training)



Tuesdays: April 9, 16, 23, 30 from 6:30 – 8:30 pm *in-person only **limited space available

Bridges out of Poverty is a framework for understanding poverty. This training will help educators start to understand the hardships that families living in poverty face every day. There is a big misconception that poverty is caused by

poor individual behaviours or choices, but so many other factors can contribute to a family experiencing poverty. We will discuss the individual circumstances, community conditions, exploitation and social/economic structures that can lead to life in poverty as well as how we can support these families without adding extra stress to their already stressful lives.

Participants will review poverty research, examine a theory of change, and analyze poverty through the prism of the hidden rules of class, resources, family structure, and language. The focus of the workshop is to provide a broad overview of concepts. This training assists employers, community organizations, social service agencies, and individuals gain insight and strategies.

A certificate of completion will be provided to participants who attend all 4 sessions.

Part 1- Introduction to Trauma and Resiliency

We will discuss trauma and how it impacts our brains and bodies over the life span. We will consider how COVID fits in with this information, how trauma shows up/what to watch for, and how to engage with kids and families in ways that disrupt and interrupt the negative impacts of trauma while helping to build resiliency for the future. The last half hour (8-8:30) will be a Q&A session (we will not record this portion).

Part 2- Managing Stress and Building Your Own Resiliency

Your work supporting children and their families is so important – who is taking care of you? We will spend time talking about stress, antidotes for stress, and how to build resiliency to help keep your buckets as full as possible.
